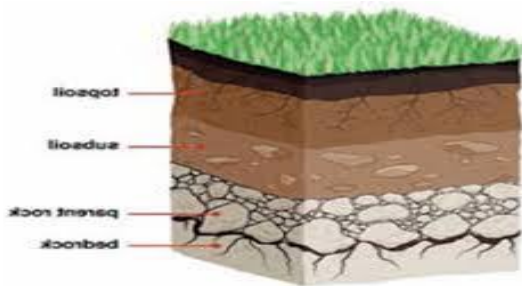

Similarly, he annexed Karnataka and Thanjavur by abolishing the titles and pensions of their respective rulers.
