14. Ans: Secularism is generally a belief that nobody should be discriminated against based on the religion they follow. Regardless of the religion he/she follows, they are equal according to the laws & regulations that govern the nation.
  
15. Organic farming is growing of agricultural and horticultural crops making no use of synthetic fertilizers and pesticides. The farming follows natural methods, like using manure, crop rotation, intercropping, biological pest control etc to grow chemical free products.
  
16. Primary activities are directly dependent on the environment as these refer to utilization of earth's resources such as land, water, vegetation, building materials and minerals. It includes hunting and gathering, pastoral activities, fishing, forestry, agriculture, mining and quarrying. Secondary activities or manufacturing are those activities which change raw materials into products of more value to people. Changing of pulp of wood into paper and paper into notebook represents the two stages of the manufacturing process.
