Who joined them afterwards?</p> <p>Ans: There were three men in the team that went to Bishnupur forest—SC De, Chief Wildlife Warden of the state; Subrata Choudhuri, an officer specialising in tranquilising animals; and the speaker. They went to the forest to treat an injured elephant. A veterinary officer (who had no experience of treating elephants) joined them afterwards.</p>

Why or why not?</p> <p>Ans: No, the speaker and his team were not irresponsible. Although they wanted to stay around for the elephant's revival, they could not have done that because there was no tree that was strong enough to support a machan where the team could spend the night.
